- Participants will be offered on-campus accommodation and a travel subsidy (up to HK\$3,000 for participants from outside China) ; this Summer School programme is free.

- Lab visits of our facilities and campus tour
- Individual meetings with EE professors
- Admissions interview for entry in 2020/21
