

Hong Kong PhD Fellowship Scheme - HKPFS

With the aim to recruit the brightest students from around the world to pursue their PhD studies in Hong Kong, the Government of Hong Kong has established the Hong Kong PhD Fellowship Scheme (HKPFS). Currently, **HKPFS provides a stipend of HK\$25,100 (~US\$3,218) per month** and the University further provides an **entrance scholarship worth HK\$77,496 (~US\$9,935)**. HKPFS applicants are also automatically considered for Regular Admission to the University.

Regular Admission



Applicants can alternatively choose to apply for regular admission without going through HKPFS and also be financially supported. The tentative studentship rate is HK\$16,500 per month throughout the normative study period.

English Requirements

Except for applicants from universities using English as the medium of instruction, the University stipulates a minimum language requirement of

- IELTS 6.5 or
- TOEFL ibt 79 (or equivalent)
- For exceptional applicants with strong academic and research track records, a minimum score of 490 in CET-Band 6 may be considered for the English requirement. However, CET is not recognized as a sufficient proof of English proficiency for HKPFS.

Application Deadlines

- → For HKPFS, the application is due on **1 Dec 2018** (by 12:00 noon Hong Kong time).
- For regular admission, there are different rounds throughout the year. The earliest rounds are due on 1 Sep 2018 and 1 Nov 2018. The normal round is due on 1 Dec 2018. Applications received after the deadline will be considered depending on the availability of positions and funding.
