Guideline on HSBC Greater Bay Area (Hong Kong) Scholarship

1. Programme Objective

HSBC aims to provide our communities with the skills and knowledge needed to thrive in the global economy by supporting charitable programmes that help people in the community develop the skills for the jobs of today and tomorrow. To help Hong Kong's next generation prepare for a future that is increasingly intertwined with the Greater Bay Area (GBA), a new HSBC Greater Bay Area (Hong Kong) Scholarship is established to encourage Hong Kong students to acquire the necessary skills and knowledge that will help them become competitive, confident, and employable as they pursue a successful and rewarding career in GBA.

2. The Award

Up to 100 students from across Hong Kong are to be identified in the 2020/21, 2021/22, 2022/23 academic years to receive a one-time scholarship award of HKD80,000 which is intended for uses that help realise the awardees' career plan in GBA. Awardees will also be offered:

- a. Membership in an extensive network of past, current and future recipients of HSBC-funded programmes; as well as a community of like-minded young professionals, providing continuous support and networking opportunities
- b. Mentorship, internship and other real-life learning opportunities offered by GBA-active businesses
- c. Dedicated learning opportunities and resources that aim to develop their preparedness for a GBA-specific career plan.

3. Eligibility

College / School / Academic Unit may nominate full-time undergraduate students, studying any discipline, who meet the following requirements:

- a. Hong Kong permanent residents with the right of abode in Hong Kong
- b. Minimum cumulative grade point average (CGPA) score of 3.0 or top 15% of class / department in the first semester of the current academic year
- c. Commitment to pursue employment, entrepreneurship or advanced academic opportunities in GBA.

4. Selection Criteria

Students will be shortlisted and selected based on the following criteria:

- a. A realistic and an ambitious plan for a long-term career in GBA
- b. An in-depth understanding of skills and knowledge required to achieve the career plan
- c. Candidates with a focus on strategic sectors (e.g. digital, innovation and technology, logistics, green energy) will be given an advantage.
- d. Future leaders who demonstrate all-roundedness
- e. Commitment to be an active member of a community of HSBC Scholars

5. Application Process

- College / School / Academic Unit should nominate eligible candidates by sending completed application forms to Career and Leadership Centre (CLC) by email at clc.careercentre@cityu.edu.hk no later than 19 March 2021 (Friday).
- CLC will coordinate institutional submission to HSBC for consideration.
- Shortlisted candidates will be invited to a final interview by HSBC on 31 May 2021.
- As candidates are shortlisted and selected on a competitive basis, there is no guarantee that any, or all, candidates nominated will be invited to the interview or will receive a scholarship.

6. Announcement and Scholarship Payment

- Selection result will be announced with endorsement by the Hongkong Bank Foundation in mid-2021.
- Payment of the scholarship award will be arranged via CLC afterwards.

7. Student Reports

Awardees will submit a report to reflect on their personal growth and learning journey towards their GBA aspirations after one year of being awarded the scholarship.

Full-time undergraduate students, studying any discipline, who meet the following requirements:

- Hong Kong permanent residents with the right of abode in Hong Kong
- Minimum cumulative grade point average (CGPA) score of 3.0 or top 15% of class / department in the first semester of the current academic year
- Commitment to pursue employment, entrepreneurship or advanced academic opportunities in GBA.
