## **HSBC Overseas Scholarship 2019/20**

The scholarship is designated to **non-final-year UGC-funded local** undergraduate students of approved study programmes in the University.

#### Aims of the award

• To support outstanding students to study abroad at specific renowned Universities overseas for one semester **OR** one academic year in 2019/20.

#### **Eligibilities**

- Hong Kong permanent residents with the right of abode in Hong Kong.
- Minimum cumulative grade point average (CGPA) score of 3.7 or top 3% of class/department, in Semester A of 2018/19 academic year.
- Well-rounded, participating in extra-curricular and community service activities.
- Commitment to Hong Kong.
- No extensive experience of living or studying overseas.
- Priority will be given to candidates who are in a financial situation that does not permit overseas study or extensive overseas travel.
- Valid results report of TOEFL <u>or</u> IELTS\*. The test must be taken **between 19 February 2017** to 15 January 2019. Test results report will have to be ready on or before 19 February 2019.

#### Value of scholarships

The maximum total value for each scholarship is **HK\$300,000**.

#### **Application Methods**

- 1. Interested students can submit an application form **OR** be nominated by his/her college or school.
- 2. Application forms are available on the website of Student Development Services (SDS) or from respective colleges/schools.

Deadline for application/nomination: 5 pm of 15 January 2019.

\*A minimum total TOEFL score of 90 (Internet-based test) with scores for individual sections not lower than 22 on listening, 17 on writing, 21 on reading, and 21 on speaking; or a minimum IELTS overall band score of 6.5, with no component below 6.0. This requirement is irrespective of the admission requirement of the intended overseas universities.
