Fang Brothers Whole Person Development Scholarships 肇豐全人發展獎學金

Regulations

With an aim to encourage and recognize students in the pursuit of whole person development, the Fang Brothers Whole Person Development Scholarships have been established commencing from the 2004/2005 academic year. In 2014, Dr Kenneth Fang generously made a further donation in support of setting up an endowment fund to perpetuate the Fang Brothers Whole Person Development Scholarships. The following regulations shall apply as of 2022/2023:

- 1. The Scholarships shall be known as "Fang Brothers Whole Person Development Scholarships" (肇 豐全人發展獎學金).
- 2. There shall be a maximum of two annual scholarships.
- 3. The value of each scholarship shall be HK\$100,000, supporting the recipients' tuition fee, living expenses and participation fees for meaningful learning activities.
- 4. The Scholarships shall be granted to full-time non-first-year undergraduate degree students who meet the following criteria:
 - *i. have demonstrated outstanding performance and contribution in the seven areas of Whole Person Development, i.e. spiritual, intellectual, physical, social, aesthetic, career and emotional aspects* (德、智、體、群、美、事、情);
 - *ii. have demonstrated special talents or contributions to the community; and*
 - iii. have achieved a CGPA of 3.2 or above in the last term/semester at CityU.
- 5. Student Development Services shall invite nominations/applications in late October 2022. Shortlisted candidates will be invited to attend selection interview(s) in January/ February 2023. Candidates who failed to attend the interview(s) in-person will <u>not</u> be considered for the Scholarship.
- 6. Recipients of Fang Brothers Whole Person Development Scholarships are <u>not</u> allowed to hold concurrent scholarships of any kind or value, and / or other prizes of value more than HK\$100,000, in the 2022/2023 academic year.
- 7. The Scholarship can only be provided to the same student <u>once</u> over the entire study programme.

<u>Remark</u>:

With an objective to nurture our students and to promote caring culture, the University encourages each award recipient to make an annual donation of HK\$200 or more to the City University of Hong Kong for student support via CityU Alumni Giving Club when they are in employment after graduation. This term has been incorporated into all scholarship/prize/award/bursary schemes since February 2008.
