### HKAUW Undergraduate Scholarships (2023/24)

#### *Application Details*

##### **Aim**

The Undergraduate Scholarships aim at recognising and encouraging **female students** with exceptional academic attainments and active involvement in community service.

##### **Award**

Each HKAUW Undergraduate Scholarship recipient will receive a certificate and an award of HK\$5,000.

##### **Eligibility criteria:**

###### *The applicant*

- a. must be currently registered as a full-time female student (**except first and final year students**) at a local degree-granting tertiary institution (designation determined by HKAUW)
- b. **must be an UNDERGRADUATE** member of HKAUW
- c. **must be nominated** by the head of department or faculty/school in which she is currently registered
- d. has outstanding academic achievements
- e. demonstrates current participation and active involvement in community service
- f. has **TWO** recommendation letters, one from her current academic supervisor and one from the community/voluntary service organization she is involved in
- g. is required to **serve the community** for at least half a year **AFTER** she receives the scholarship which may include participating in **community services project organized by HKAUW**

##### **Application procedure:**

- h. Complete the HKAUW “Membership Application Form” online at <http://www.hkauw.org/membership> to become an Undergraduate Member of HKAUW
- i. Directly deposit the Undergraduate Membership fee to HKAUW at **Bank of East Asia** Account: **015-176-68-00002-2** via bank counter, and upload the online Membership Application Form together with the copy of the transaction receipt which contains the payment reference number.
- j. **Retain** a copy of the transaction receipt or the bank’s acknowledgement statement as proof of fee payment
- k. The completed HKAUW Undergraduate Scholarship Application Form including **only** relevant information together with all required supporting documents, and **two** recommendation letters (one from her current academic supervisor and one from the community/voluntary service organization she is involved in), and the **original** transaction receipt or the bank’s acknowledgement statement, must be received by

HKAUW by **5:00 p.m. on 29<sup>th</sup> October 2023** via the **Student Affairs Office** of her institution. **HKAUW WILL NOT CONSIDER ANY LATE APPLICATION.**

- l. Applications will not be considered without supporting documents.
- m. The completed application forms with supporting documents must be posted to:

### **Announcement of Results**

- a. Final scholarship recipients may be selected with or without an interview.
- b. The Scholarship Director will notify the nominating institutions and the scholarship recipients directly when the recipients are selected.
- c. Applicants who are not notified by 15<sup>th</sup> **December 2023** should consider their applications unsuccessful. HKAUW does NOT provide critiques for unsuccessful applications.

### **Presentation of Awards:**

Successful Undergraduate Scholarship Recipients are required to make a short presentation of their research topic at HKAUW's 2023 Scholarship Presentation Ceremony. Details of which will be announced later.

(NOTE 25% of the Awards, namely HK\$1,250 will be retained by HKAUW and awarded to the recipients subsequent to receipt of written proof of community services between January and August 2023 from the recipients concerned.)
