HSBC Hong Kong Scholarship

Regulations

The Hongkong Bank Foundation has kindly decided to establish a number of scholarships to the University since the 2012/13 academic year. The following regulations shall apply as of 2023/24:

1. *The Scholarship shall be known as the “HSBC Hong Kong Scholarship”.*
2. *There shall be NINE scholarships in maximum; the value of each scholarship shall be HK\$50,000.*
3. *The Scholarships shall be awarded to UGC-funded full-time local undergraduate students who meet the following requirements:*
 - a) *Hong Kong permanent residents with the right of abode in Hong Kong;*
 - b) *achieved CGPA 3.7 or above / are the top 3% of class/department by the Semester A of the current academic year;*
 - c) *well-roundedness, participating in extra-curricular and community activities;*
 - d) *commitment to Hong Kong; and*
 - e) *demonstrated strong financial needs.*
4. *Nominations from Colleges/Schools shall reach Student Development Services by late January each year. Nominees shall be invited to attend a selection interview in person.*
5. *The donor will notify the University each year on whether or not the Scholarship will be renewed for the following academic year.*

Remark:

With an objective to nurture our students and to promote caring culture, the University encourages each award recipient to make an annual donation of HK\$200 or more to the City University of Hong Kong for student support via CityU Alumni Giving Club when they are in employment after graduation. This term has been incorporated into all scholarship/prize/award/bursary schemes since February 2008.
